Requirements

Minimum requirements in addition to the general qualifications aforementioned:

1. Bachelor of science in nursing degree
2. Master's Degree
3. An English proficiency test score equivalent to one of the followings or above for those whose native language is not English:
TOEFL ITP 500, CBT 173, iBT 61, IELTS 4.5 or TOEIC 600
4. If applicants holds a Bachelor's or Master's degree from United States or other Anglophone countries are exempt from the above TOEFL/IELTS/TOEIC requirement.
5. If applicants holds a conditional letter of acceptance, the English proficiency document can submit in six months after enrollment.

Additional Documents Required

In addition to the "Required Documents" on page to

1. Curriculum vitae
2. Autobiography
3. English abstract for master thesis or for academic publications
4. Bachelor's and Master's degree in English transcript
5. Study plan
6. Two recommendation letters

Evaluation for Admission

All documents submitted to the Office of Academic Affairs will be assessed by the Committee of School of Nursing for the initial screening. If necessary, an interview will be conducted via telecommunication. Accepted applicants will be notified individually after the evaluation is completed.

【English Requirement for Graduation】

Doctoral degree students need to submit at least one of the following English proficiency pass test score prior to their PhD dissertation exam:
